IS THE FATHER OF THE BABY REQUIRED TO HELP ME?

Co-parenting is possible, whether you intend to have a future with the father of your baby or not. If he is interested in parenting with you, we have a program designed specifically for men. Ask your Advocate for more information.

Regardless of his involvement, fathers have a responsibility to help support your child. Many states will help you pursue court-ordered child support from the father of the baby.
